**Amendment #6 to Invitation for Bids (IFB)
CCU Account Verification Services
Solicitation No. F10B4400003
September 12, 2013**

This Amendment is being issued to amend and clarify certain information contained in the above named IFB. All information contained herein is binding on all Bidders who respond to this IFB. Specific parts of the IFB have been amended. The following changes/additions are listed below. New language has been double underlined and marked in bold (ex. **new language**), and language deleted has been marked with a strikeout (ex. ~~language deleted~~).

1. AMEND Section 3.2.4 of the IFB to ADD as follows:

3.2.4.3 When a Bidder is notified that it is the apparent successful Bidder, the apparent successful Bidder at that time will submit its limited provisions addressing product licensing and proprietary rights that the Department will consider relative to the credentialing process, provided that the requested provisions conform with the stipulations contained in Section 3.2.4.2. The Department and apparent successful Bidder will execute the Contract and licensing and credentialing document by no later than September 20, 2013 at 5 p.m. Eastern Standard Time, and that date and time will be the date and time of execution of the Contract and licensing and credentialing agreement for all purposes. However, in the event that the Department and apparent successful Bidder cannot agree upon licensing and credentialing provisions, then that Bidder will be notified that it is no longer eligible for the award, and the Department will notify the next apparent successful Bidder and repeat this process with that Bidder after establishing a new deadline.
